



COVID-19 Precautions and Procedures

Sonoma Raceway and the Sears Point Racing Experience have implemented safety procedures to discourage the spread of COVID-19 and protect the health of all guests and raceway employees. Please review these procedures and policies before coming to the raceway.

IF YOU ARE EXPERIENCING ANY COLD/FLU-LIKE SYMPTOMS OR HAVE RECENTLY BEEN IN CONTACT WITH SOMEONE DIAGNOSED WITH COVID-19, PLEASE STAY HOME AND CONTACT US BY PHONE OR EMAIL

General Policies:

- Facial coverings must be worn at all times except when wearing a full-face helmet or in your personal vehicle.
- Frequent handwashing and hand sanitization are encouraged.
- Drivers must keep a minimum 6' social distance between other drivers and instructors.
- Drivers are encouraged to bring their own water.

Sign-In/Liability Forms:

- Reservation and payments must be made on the Sears Point Racing Experience website prior to your event.
- Check-in will take place outside or in a well-ventilated room with single-use pens.

Classroom Sessions / Facilities:

- Classroom sessions will be conducted outside. In the event of rain, sessions will take place in ventilated, socially-distanced spaces.

Vehicles:

- For karting programs, drivers will be assigned a kart for the day.
- For car programs, cars will be paddocked 20' apart and no passengers are allowed in cars.
- If a driver needs assistance with seatbelts, the driver must close their helmet visor and the instructor will be wearing a facemask and gloves.
- In the event of an on-track incident, drivers must remain in their vehicles while safety crews assess the scene.

Helmets/Gear:

- Drivers are required to leave helmets in their vehicle until the end of the day.
- Drop off safety gear in the designated area when your program is complete.
- All safety gear is thoroughly cleaned and sanitized each day.
